What is violence?

Violence is a physical or psychological act intended to prevent someone else from doing what they want to do, forcing them to do something that they do not want to do, or keeping them under your power and control.

Partner violence includes physical aggression, threats, abuse and sexual coercion. It also includes various types of controlling behaviour, such as isolating someone from their friends and family or otherwise restricting their options in life.
